ISUOG Outreach volunteer opportunities

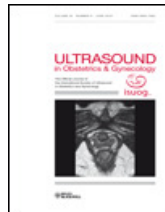
ISUOG is excited to be offering three volunteer placements for individuals who would like to participate in the ISUOG Outreach programme in Haiti.
