### Call for papers: new and emerging technologies in prenatal diagnosis

In January 2015, *Ultrasound in Obstetrics & Gynecology* will be publishing a special themed issue on emerging DNA and sequencing technologies in perinatology. All articles published in this issue will be freely accessible to non-subscribers.

We are interested in receiving original research articles and systematic reviews on all aspects of new and emerging technologies and techniques in prenatal diagnosis, especially related to non-invasive prenatal testing (NIPT), DNA/exome sequencing and CGH microarray analysis.

Articles on basic science, genetic epidemiology, emerging clinical challenges, as well as intervention trials will be considered for publication. Articles from low- and high-risk populations are welcome but should emphasise the relevance of the study findings with respect to clinical practice and/or understanding disease etiology.

*Ultrasound in Obstetrics & Gynecology* has a Journal Impact Factor of **3.557** and is ranked 8th out of 78 journals in the category of obstetrics and gynecology. Papers submitted for this special edition will be fast-track peer reviewed.
