




Delegates by profession/speciality







Delegates by geography






Top 10 countries

Top ten countries registered









The critical cervical length is 2.14 cm which has a sensitivity of 88.9% (0.889) and specificity of 66.3% (0.663) where 80% of patients achieved vaginal delivery within 12 hours.

The null hypothesis was accepted because the p value 0.002 which is < 0.05, indicating there is statistically significant relationship between the Critical Cx Lt and induction to delivery interval The test result variable(s): ULTRASOUND CERVICAL LENGTH has at least one tie between the positive actual state group and the negative actual state group.










Platform use statistics for live Congress dates


Number of delegates on platform, per day (live Congress dates)
