Certificates of attendance

Live stream delegates who have logged in to the event will be sent a link to fill in an online evaluation form to receive a certificate of attendance following the course. Once this survey has been completed you will be redirected to our website where you can download and print off your certificate.

Lecture recordings

The course will be professionally recorded. After the event has concluded the lecture recordings will be available for review on demand by registered delegates until 21st May 2018 on the live streaming website. After this point, <u>some</u> of the lectures may be made available on ISUOG's CME platform. The selection of lectures available from the course will be at the discretion of, and on a timeline determined by, ISUOG's Education Committee.

Technical considerations

To view the webcast, your computer must be connected to the internet via a Broadband / ADSL or other high speed connection and you will need to have headphones or speakers connected to hear the audio. A test video will be uploaded on the live stream website, please feel free to log-in to test your connection next week before the event. On the day of the course we recommend you login 10 minutes before it's due to start.

Timing & Interaction

The program will broadcast on Athens, Eastern European Summer Time (EEST). We recommend you log-in at the equivalent local time to ensure you can ask technical and clinical questions of our speakers and moderators. Unfortunately we cannot respond to queries submitted to the live streaming website outside of course hours.
