

ISUOG India Symposium, E-Poster Process and Criteria



1. Purpose and Intention

The E-Poster session of the program encourages sharing of research, clinical experience, and innovative practice in ultrasound in obstetrics and gynaecology. It provides a platform for the best research by clinicians, trainees, and researchers to be presented, in a room of their peers. E-Posters complement the course by highlighting clinically relevant work.

The top 3 ranked E-Posters will receive an exclusive ISUOG prize announced during the E-Poster session

- E-Posters have no presentation attached.
- There are no questions.
- It is a slideshow and will be on the screens in the room.
- It will be on the platform for all delegates to view online and on-demand.
- There is no action required of accepted e-posters presenters except physical attendance.

2. Submission Process

Submission window: Monday 9 February to Friday 27 February or until slots are filled

Format: 1-page PowerPoint slide, saved as a PDF

Language: English

Submitted via: Email education@isuog.org with the Subject Line: "E-Poster submission for ISUOG India Symposium".

To be considered applicants must submit only 1-page PowerPoint slide, in the format as a PDF and their proof of traineeship (if applicable). No other materials will be accepted.

Submissions are accepted on a **first-come, first-served** basis and reviewed until all slots are filled. **Early submission is recommended.** All submissions should follow format guidelines and present original work, clinical experience, or educational material in relation to Ultrasound of Obstetrics and Gynecology.

- All submitters will receive **10% discount code** for onsite attendance.
- If submission includes proof of traineeship, trainee submitters will receive a **15% discount code** for onsite attendance.
- These discounts can be used in combination with other discounts

Proof of status: All trainees and residents will need to submit proof of their trainee, or resident status by way of a letter from their Department or Institution. The letter must be in English and dated within the last 6 months. The document/photocopy/picture can be submitted with your application.

3. Benefits for Accepted Authors

In order for the e-poster to be displayed onsite, all acceptances must be registered for onsite attendance. Please register for the event using the same information provided for the e-Poster submission.

- Increased visibility and contribution to the Symposium's scientific programme.

4. Review and Marking Criteria

Each submission will be reviewed independently by **two reviewers (faculty of the course)**, and scores will be averaged. Total possible marks: **55**

Acceptance Threshold: Minimum **35 marks** required for E-Poster acceptance.

Scientific Aspects (40 marks)

- Novel or relevant clinical question – 10
- Sound methodology – 10
- Clinically meaningful findings – 10
- Clear, justified conclusions – 10

Communication Aspects (15 marks)

- Clear structure and concise messaging – 5
- Legible design and strong visual hierarchy – 5
- Conclusions prominent and easy to grasp – 5

Display and Presentation Tips

- Ensure legibility and clarity.
- Highlight key conclusions.
- Use figures or images to communicate efficiently.

Clear, clinically relevant submissions with concise messaging have the highest chance of acceptance.

ISUOG will inform all submissions of their acceptance or rejection by Monday 2nd March 2026 latest.

5. E-Poster Advise – Suggested format

Introduction / Background

- Brief context or rationale for the work
- State why this topic is important in ultrasound in OBGYN

Objectives / Aims

- Clearly list the aim(s) of your study or project

Methods / Approach

- Bullet points describing how the work was conducted
- Include study design, population, or approach if relevant

Results / Findings

- Use concise bullet points or a small figure/table
- Highlight the main observations or outcomes

Discussion / Interpretation

- Briefly describe the significance of your findings
- What do these results mean clinically or practically?

Conclusion / Key Takeaways

- One or two clear statements summarising the main points

References / Acknowledgements (Optional)

- Keep minimal (if needed)
- Include funding or institutional support

Design and Layout Tips

- Keep text legible: font size ≥ 18 pt for body, ≥ 24 pt for headings
- Use clear headings to guide the reader
- Use 1–2 simple figures or graphs; avoid clutter
- Maintain consistent alignment and spacing

TIPS FOR A GREAT E-POSTER!

- Keep text clear and concise
- Use 1–2 visuals
- Highlight key points

References / Acknowledgements (Optional)

- Add any references or acknowledgements here
