#### Welcome

We are delighted you will be attending **ISUOG's Education Course: Urogynecology and pelvic floor ultrasound.** The course will take place in London, UK on 6 July 2019. The following information has been prepared to assist you with your arrival in London and to facilitate your attendance at the course.

#### Venue

The venue for the course is the ISUOG Secretariat located at 122 Freston Road, London W10 6TR.

#### **Travelling via the Heathrow Express**

From Heathrow airport, you can take the Heathrow Express to Paddington in central London, which leaves every 15 minutes until 22:00. Tickets can be purchased when you arrive in London or online beforehand at <a href="www.heathrowexpress.com">www.heathrowexpress.com</a>. Tickets are priced at £37.00 for an open return and the journey from Heathrow should take 15 – 20 minutes. From Paddington, we suggest you use London Underground services to reach Shepherd's Bush Market (Hammersmith and City line) or Shepherd's Bush Station (Central line). If you are arriving directly to the course venue, alight at Latimer Road Station (Hammersmith and City line).

#### **Travelling by Tube**

The two closest London Tube Stations to the ISUOG Secretariat are Latimer Road (Hammersmith and City line) and Shepherd's Bush (Central line or Overground line). To plan your journey to these destinations, please visit www.tfl.gov.uk/.

Prior to your Tube journey, it is best to purchase and charge an 'Oyster' travel card from any Tube station which will allow you to travel on all London Underground, Overground, DLR and bus services at discounted rates. The card costs £5 which is refundable when returned to any station office. The cost of each trip you take will be deducted from your Oyster at a rate dependant on the time of day and length of journey.Please visit <a href="www.tfl.gov.uk/">www.tfl.gov.uk/</a> for further details about pricing.
