# ULTRASOUND ESSENTIALS 2026

On Friday 23 and Saturday 24 January 2026, **ISUOG** and the **Fetal Medicine Foundation (FMF)** presented the fifth edition of **Ultrasound Essentials**. This was a two-day free online event for all clinicians working in low-resource settings, kindly supported by GE HealthCare as the sole sponsor.

This event played a hugely important part in the missions of both **ISUOG** and **FMF**:



The event has been recorded and is now available on demand for registered delegates for 6 months from the live event's end.



at the live event:




Top 10 countries
