

Volunteer Observer Trainer – Position Description

Position: Outreach Observer Trainer – Virtual Trainee Support Program

Purpose: to virtually support a local trainee in Sudan or Oman develop their OB/GYN ultrasound skills by observing and commenting on images via WhatsApp.

Project Description: Having completed Phase I of the Outreach programs in Sudan and Oman, a number of trainees have been selected to become local trainers. In order to develop their teaching skills a virtual training program is to be implemented over the next 6 months. Each local trainer is now leading a WhatsApp in which they will provide feedback and mentorship to 5 local trainees.

Your role will be to monitor this WhatsApp group and mentor 1 local trainer, so they are able to conduct high-quality training sessions in 6 months' time.

Location: Home based

Duration: 6 months, 30 minutes per week

Key responsibilities:

- Monitoring the WhatsApp group to ensure correct information is provided
- Providing feedback on images, teaching skills and analysis of 1 trainee
- Providing advice and support when needed

Expectations:

- Provide feedback to 1 trainee a minimum of once per week
- A minimum commitment of 6 months
- Develop a strong mentor relationship with trainee

NB: The purpose of this role is to provide mentorship; not to offer medical advice or diagnosis.

Qualifications:

Essential:

- OB/GYN ultrasound Practitioner.
- Experience in teaching/training in OB/GYN ultrasound
- Fluency in English.
- Cultural sensitivity and consideration
- An open mind and patience
- Current ISUOG Member

Desirable:

- Fluency in Arabic language skills
