On the day of the webinar we recommend you <u>login 10 minutes before it's due to start</u> to test your connection, you can play any video on the internet and if it plays smoothly then so will the webinar. You should see a holding slide and music prior to the webinar start time. <u>If you are already logged in but experiencing problems viewing the webinar</u>, refresh your browser and press play again.
