The Virtual World Congress on Ultrasound in Obstetrics and Gynecology will inaugurate the celebration of the 30th anniversary of the International Society of Ultrasound in Obstetrics and Gynecology (ISUOG).

The Society grew from "an awareness that we needed an international society to act as a forum for in-depth analysis and presentation of advances in ultrasound diagnosis in all aspects of our specialty, to be an influential body, setting standards for training and monitoring the safety of ultrasound in obstetric and gynecological diagnosis, and to hold a major conference every year to explore the most recent developments in the field and to bring together professionals who use ultrasound to improve clinical care"^[1]. A team of enthusiastic professors and fellows built a fantastic program for the first World Congress, which took place in London (even the weather was good) in January 1991 and brought together more than 1000 delegates. The best minds and most outstanding experts in ultrasound in obstetrics and gynecology were amongst them. The first issue of the Journal, [Ultrasound in Obstetrics and Gynecology](#), was published at the same time.

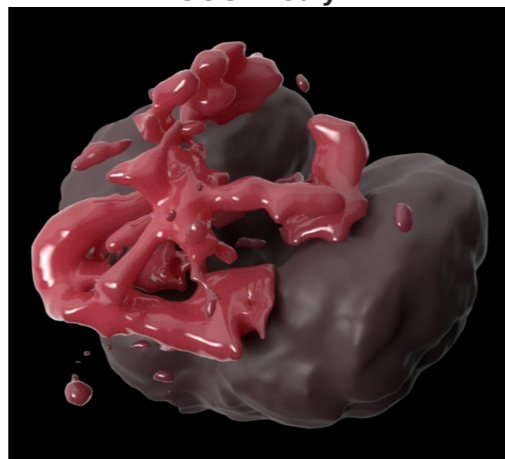

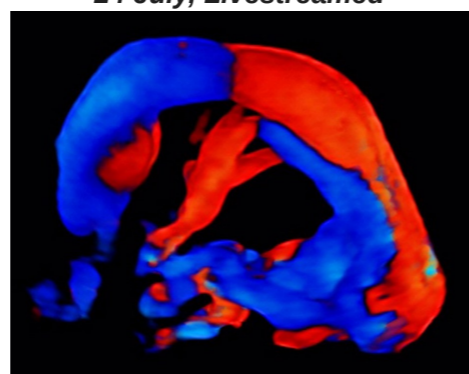
