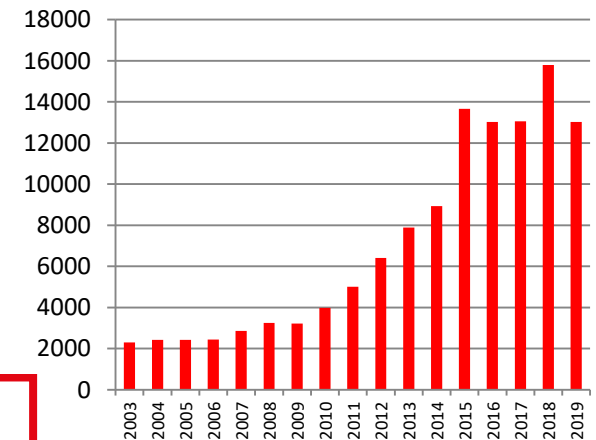
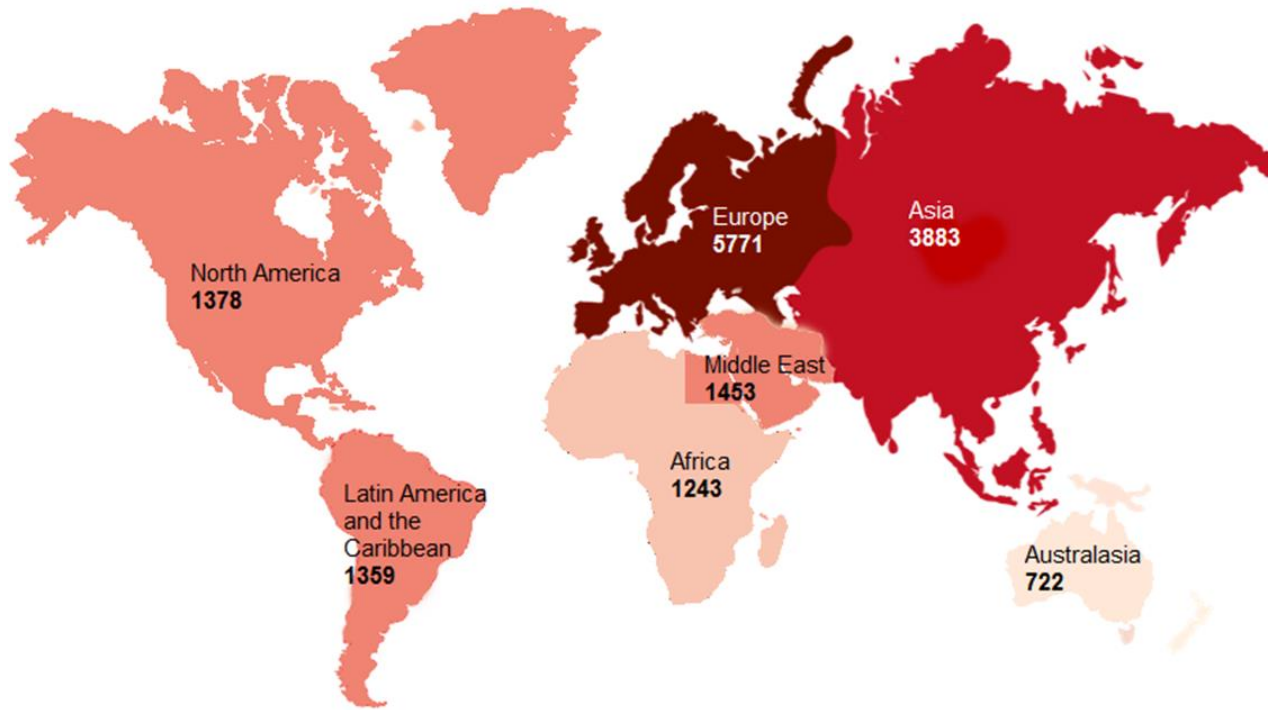
Our mission is to improve women's health through the provision, advancement and broadest dissemination of the highest quality education, standards and research information around ultrasound in obstetrics and gynecology.

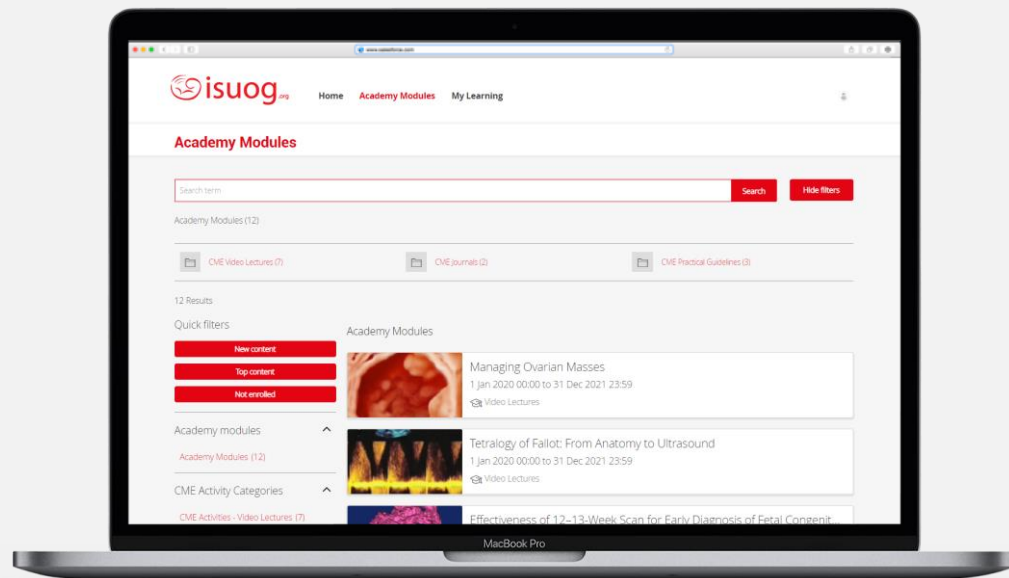

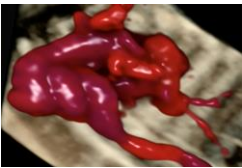

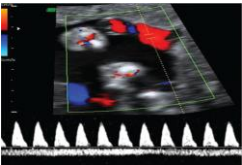
