Travelling by Tube

The easiest and fastest way to navigate London is by using the London Underground (tube). The two closest London Tube Stations to the ISUOG Secretariat are Latimer Road (Hammersmith and City line) and Shepherd's Bush (Central line or Overground line). Shepherd's Bush Market (Hammersmith and City line) is the closest station to the Dorsett Hotel but Shepherd's Bush on the Central or Overground lines is also within walking distance. Prior to your Tube journey, it is best to purchase and charge an 'Oyster' travel card from any Tube station which will allow you to travel on all London Underground, Overground, DLR and bus services at discounted rates.
