Joining Instructions

Welcome

On behalf of the Organising Committee we are delighted that you will be joining us at the 27th World Congress on Ultrasound in Obstetrics and Gynecology in Vienna, Austria, 16-19 September 2017 (Pre-Congress courses & ISUOG Basic Training 15 September). We hope this information helps you prepare for your Congress experience and we look forward to welcoming you to Vienna!

Congress venue:

Austria Center Vienna IAKW - AG Internationales Amtssitz- und Konferenzzentrum Wien, AG Bruno-Kreisky-Platz 1 A-1220 Vienna, Austria Closest station (5 mins walk): Kaisermühlen station

Arrival in Vienna

There are a number of ways to travel into the city from Vienna International Airport. We ask all of our visitors to think of the environment and use public transport wherever possible.

City Airport Train CAT

- 16 minutes to Landstrasse/Wien Mitte station. From there it is 20 minutes with 1 change and 7 stops by U-bahn (underground train) to Kaisermühlen station (closest station to Melia, Arcotel & ACV) and a 5 minute walk at the other end.
- Frequency: every 30 minutes
- Price: €11, return: €19

Rail S-bahn commuter railway (S7)

- 27 minutes to Landstrasse / Wien Mitte station. From there it is 20 minutes with 1 change and 7 stops by U-bahn (underground train) to Kaisermühlen station (closest station to Melia, Arcotel & ACV) and a 5 minute walk at the other end.
- Frequency: every 30 minutes during the day
- Price: As the airport is located outside the Vienna city zone, you will need two single tickets: one for the zone up to the Vienna city limits for €1.70 and a
 ticket for the Vienna city zone for €2.20.

Bus: airport shuttle (drops to hotel)

- Direct service to the Austria Center Vienna: 30 minutes (stop: Wien Kaisermühlen-Kagran 5 mins from hotel)
- City centre: 17–45 minutes (other stops: Schwedenplatz, Wien Westbahnhof, Rathaus, Schottentor, Volkstheater)
- Frequency: every 30-60 minutes during the day

Events

The following events will take place during the Congress. If you have not yet booked but wish to attend one of the below events, please email registration@isuog.org or register and pay onsite.

- Fetal anatomy: normal or abnormal? The Basic Training approach, Friday 15 September, 08:30-17:00. The 2017 Congress Basic Training program is designed to provide trainees with the knowledge and skills required to distinguish between normal appearances and the more common abnormal ultrasound appearances in the second trimester fetus.
- **Pre-Congress course Essentials in Fetal MRI: methods and brain imaging'**, Friday 15 September, 09:00-17:50. This course is an essential overview of Fetal MRI. The expert faculty will explore typical fetal brain pathologies, discuss troubleshooting and finish with interesting case based discussions.
- **Pre-Congress course Modern obstetric management: the latest updates**, Friday 15 September, 08:00-17:50. Explore the role of ultrasound and maternal biomarkers in predicting pre-eclampsia, pre-term birth, still birth and the prenatal diagnosis of fetal genetic conditions
- CFEF hands-on workshops:

Saturday 16th 08:30-16:45. Learn how to get the right view and the right measurement, in just a few minutes with focused hands on training in collaboration with CFEF. The intimate training sessions on a specific difficult topic such as 3D surface, corpus callosum, and cerebral Doppler. Pregnant models will be in each room to assist seeing the normal view.

Food and catering

Tea, coffee and lunch will be served in the exhibition areas on the ground floor and the mezzanine/ first floor level of the ACV. The Welcome drinks will be served in the exhibition area and the Leaving drinks on Tuesday will take place in Foyer A at 16:20. Delegate or accompanying person badges will be required for catering.

Delegates can create their own agenda with our itinerary planner. You will then be able to have your uniquely created itinerary emailed to you.


Language
